Each year the Eagle Foundation will award the Beth A. Munsch Memorial Education Scholarship to a graduating Cumberland Valley High School senior who plans to pursue a degree in education at a 4-year educational institution. The scholarship will be a one-time award in the amount of \$1,500. The scholarship will be awarded during the Senior Night Awards ceremony in May in the form of a check made payable jointly to the student and academic institution. The scholarship money must be used for tuition payment to an accredited 4-year educational institution. Students eligible to apply must declare their intentions of earning an education degree. The scholarship will be awarded based on the overall achievements of the applicants and the required essay.
