



Peter Craig Breen Memorial Scholarship in Science

Peter Breen's aspirations and his love for chemistry, math, and music live on through this scholarship established in 2017 with gifts from his family and friends. Peter, a 2010 CV graduate, was humble with a kind and gentle spirit. Peter would assist anyone who needed his help and was happiest when tutoring classmates or younger students. He spent hundreds of hours doing service work as he became an Eagle Scout. Peter attended the Pennsylvania State University and did undergraduate research focusing on RNA and computational chemistry. He was accepted into three Ph.D. programs in Bioinformatics before he died in March 2014. Penn State conferred a B.S. degree in Chemistry with honors (posthumously) to Peter in May 2014. His family and friends hope this scholarship will help support students in science to make a positive difference in our world.

Each year, the Eagle Foundation will award the Peter Craig Breen Memorial Scholarship in Science to a graduating Cumberland Valley High School senior. The scholarship will be a one-time award in the amount of \$1,000. The scholarship will be awarded during the Senior Night Awards ceremony in May in the form of a check made payable jointly to the student and academic institution. The scholarship money must be used for tuition payment to an accredited 4-year educational institution.

The criteria for selection will include academic achievements, intent to pursue a degree in Chemistry, Biochemistry, Math, or Physics (Engineering majors will not be considered; including Biomedical Engineering) at a four-year educational institution, and a required essay. Preference will be given to candidates who meet the required criteria and also demonstrate participation in science activities outside the classroom, musical accomplishments, and service to the community.
